Does your school aspire to have more connection with the Arts but struggle to make it happen?

The School Explorer Fund can help you do just that.

The Fund is open exclusively to state primary schools and to special schools (primary or secondary) in the Charity's beneficial area to help you access and take part in Arts activities. Activities could include visits to the theatre, a musical experience or to a museum or art gallery.

There is no restriction on which institution you can visit, but should be within London. The activity you choose must enhance the current activities of the class or year group and be the kind of experience that the children do not normally have access to.

You can apply for:

- travel costs (including coach costs) to venues within London
- match funding for ticket prices (i.e. if your school can pay for one class to participate in an activity you could ask the Charity to support the costs of enabling a second class to also take part)
- a contribution towards the costs of participating in a venuebased education programme.

Grants under the School Explorer Fund are considered throughout the year and are not subject to deadlines. The maximum amount available under this Fund is £2,000.
